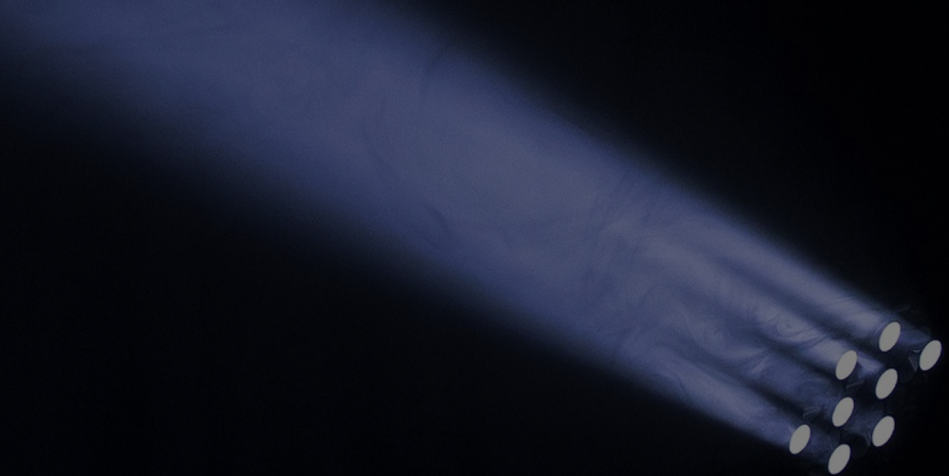

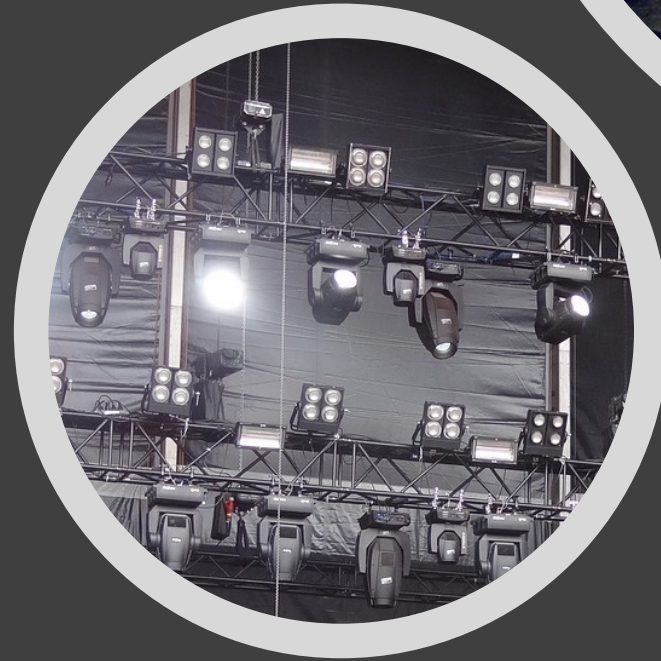

Theatre Makers in Practice

Component 1: Devising

- Create and develop a devised piece from a stimulus (free choice for centre).
- Performance of this devised piece or design realisation for this performance.
- Analyse and evaluate the devising process and performance.
- Performer or designer routes available.

Assessed in a Written Devising Log worth 45 marks and a Devised Performance worth 15 marks.





Component 2: Performance From Text

- Performance of two extracts from one play (students may contribute as performer or designer)



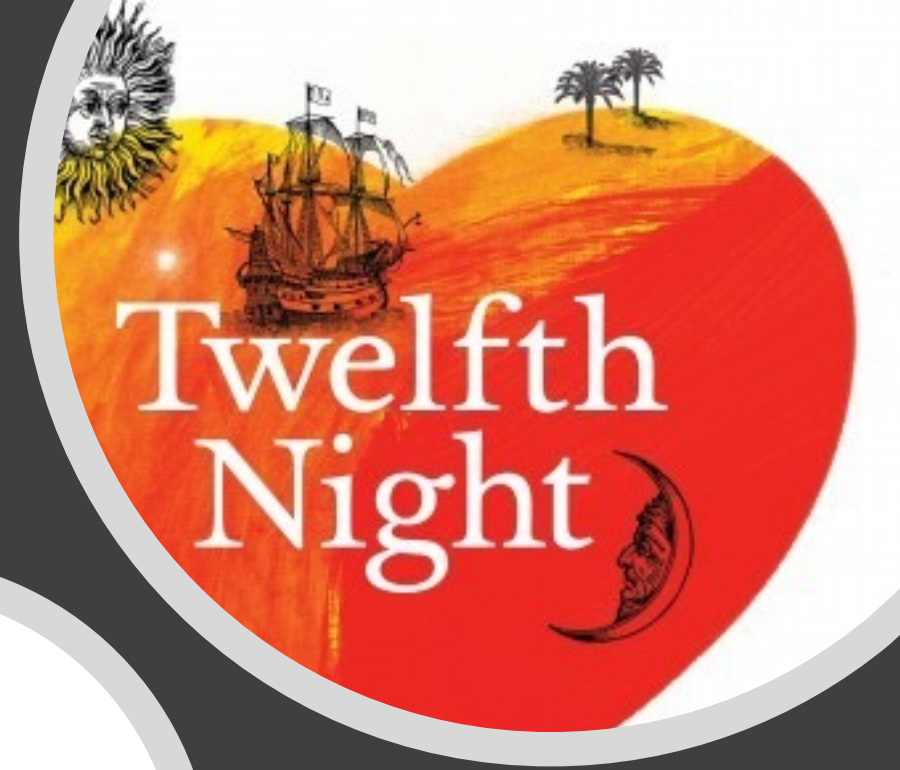

Component 3: Theatre Makers in Practice

- Knowledge and understanding of drama and theatre
- Study of one set play from a choice of six
- Analysis and evaluation of the work of live theatre makers

Assessed in a Written Exam lasting 1 hour and 45 minutes



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Component 1: Devising

Creating, performing and writing about a performance you have made yourself.

Component 2: Performance From Text

Performing extracts from a script to an examiner.

Component 3: Theatre Makers in Practice

Written Exam on a practical study of a play.
