Our school exists for the children and our distinctive Catholic ethos guides every aspect of life at SPH. We believe that it is important to make our faith relevant to young people today.

This means being outward-looking as a community; inclusive of all people, regardless of their religious beliefs, making sure we live out our faith on a day to day basis. Prayer and the sacramental life of the Church is at the heart of our school community, as is providing children with opportunities to live out the Gospel values.

Sixth Form

Post-16 education presents new and exciting challenges for the vast majority of our children who stay on for Sixth Form education, along with many others who join us from other state and private schools.

We are very blessed to have an outstanding Sixth Form provision at SPH and are very proud of all that our students achieve. The Sixth Form has its own strong identity and students enjoy the benefits of working in smaller classes, with high quality teaching, careers advice, mentoring and enrichment activities.

Being based within a school, our Sixth Form is able to offer a seamless transition for students from GCSE to A Level, helping deal with the academic challenges and personal learning skills required to be successful. As an outstanding Catholic school, we are committed to working collaboratively with others, sharing best practice and raising the standard of education for all young people. The Bosco Catholic Education Trust was opened in April 2017, originally with SPH and St Mary's Catholic Primary School, Worthing. Bosco CET is Arundel and Brighton's diocesan multi-academy trust for Sussex and works closely with all Catholic schools across East Sussex, West Sussex and Brighton & Hove.

Designated as a Teaching School in September 2017, SPH leads the Bosco Teaching School Alliance; a strong working partnership of schools who work together to provide school-led teacher training, professional development and school to school support.


